Former New York City cop Dominick Carapella on Friday provided the federal court in Brooklyn with an array of salacious details concerning his partnership with convicted killer and accused mob boss John Gotti, including why they were more likely to engage in public sex, how they met and how they could kill someone "like a shot of whiskey." The salacious testimony raises new questions about Carapella's credibility that will be explored at a hearing Friday. "We were what you call 'couple's,'" Carapella said of himself and the Gotti, telling the court the men frequently conducted sexual acts together in public and would "take walks," but have sex in a parked car, in the back of a truck or at the end of a pier. "He was my friend," Carapella told the court. "We used to go out for dinner, we would go to parties, we met people, John introduced me to a lot of people, I introduced him to a lot of people." But it was Carapella's testimony — telling the court that in the 1970s and 1980s the pair met as children in the foster care system and Gotti eventually adopted him — that rocked the case against Gotti's son and indicted underboss Anthony "Fat Tony" Salerno. Carapella, who as a child was also called "Little John," began testifying about his relationship with Gotti in October when he failed to show up for his scheduled sentencing date and a warrant was issued for his arrest. On Friday, Carapella said he has spent the last three years trying to get the decades-old sexual behavior out of his head, yet still finds his memory vivid and people still ask him about his relationship with Gotti. He said he first met Gotti at the
